Drugs reaching the embryo during this stage may result in spontaneous abortion, a sublethal gross anatomic defect (true teratogenic effect), covert embryopathy (a permanent subtle metabolic or functional defect that may manifest later in life), or increased risk of childhood cancer (if the fetus is exposed to radioactive iodine or contrast).
